Wednesday, April 25, 2018: Recital Ticket Sales at the studio. 5:30-7:30 PM (First come, first serve) We do not require you to purchase a set amount of recital tickets. <u>TICKETS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.</u> Children 3 and under do not need a ticket if they are sitting on your lap. (Cash, check and charge accepted) No videography or photography.

Saturday, May 5, 2018: Recital Flowers Form, Room Mom Form, DVD Form, and T-shirt order forms are due.

Saturday, May 12, 2018: Ad Book Forms are due. Please sell as many ads as possible, but at the least, one \$55.00 ½ page ad is required.

Ad book fees will automatically be added to your May statements due with May tuition. All ad book forms and pictures must be handed in by May 12. After May 12, we cannot accept any more ads, regardless if you have paid. Late fees for ad books payments will be applied on May 10, 2018. If you have any questions, please refer to our Policy Agreement that was handed out with registration.

Monday, May 14- Friday, May 25: You may participate in early registration for FALL 2018 during this 2-week period!

JUNE TUITION PAYMENTS MUST BE PAID BY TUESDAY MAY 29, 2018 TO ENSURE ALL PAYMENTS ARE CLEARED BEFORE OUR SHOW ON JUNE 2, 2018. ANY STUDENT WITH AN OVERDUE BALANCE AS OF THURSDAY, MAY 31, 2018 WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PERFORM IN OUR END OF YEAR RECITAL.

Parent's other than room mom's need to be out of the dressing rooms by 4:00 PM. Doors open to the auditorium at 4:00 PM. Show starts at 4:30 PM.

DRESS REHEARSAL:

THIS IS A CLOSED REHEARSAL. ONLY ONE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN PERMITTED TO ATTEND FOR EACH FAMILY

MAKE SURE YOU KNOW YOUR SCHEDULE!

PLEASE ARRIVE 30 MIN PRIOR TO CALL TIME AS WE MAY RUN AHEAD OF SCHEDULE. WE CANNOT WAIT FOR LATE STUDENTS. WE ARE ON A STRICT SCHEDULE. THANK YOU FOR YOUR UNDERSTANDING.

All Students should ARRIVE with Hair and Make-up ready in costume.

Costume – Bring all pieces of your costume to dress rehearsal. The night before, check that you have everything you need. DO NOT FORGET ANYTHING!!

This is a full dress rehearsal, so please have all shoes, costumes, hair pieces, tights, etc.

Students should arrive stretched and ready to go. If videotaping routines, please **DO NOT** post to social media until **after** recital.

Timeline Information:

- Check-in at table in lobby
- If your child is in more than one dance, a classroom will be set up as a dressing room to change in. Children who are only in one dance, please arrive in costume with full hair and make-up ready to go. Dancers and parents can watch the rehearsal until their designated time. Please ensure your child is sitting. No running around or talking loudly while dances are being ran.
- After your child has fulfilled their designated dress rehearsal times, parents and children are free to leave.

DRESS REHEARSAL ORDER:

Competition solos, duos, and small groups WILL NOT be practiced at dress rehearsal.

Competition dances will be ran WITHOUT COSTUMES for spacing. Please bring any additional costumes that will be rehearsed, i.e. Ballet and Finale.

RECITAL:

Saturday, June 2, 2018

Students to arrive at 3:30 pm, with hair and make-up ready. Please do not arrive in costume to recital.

A female parent or guardian is to check in their student(s) and walk them back to their designated dressing room. Parents other than room moms need to be out of the dressing rooms by 4:00 PM. Doors open to the auditorium at 4:00 PM. Show starts at 4:30 PM.

Flowers, 50/50, snacks, gifts, and extra tickets are sold the day of, in the front lobby

Recital To-Do List:

- Make sure you have all of your costumes, shoes, hair needs and make-up BEFORE you leave
- Check everything twice!
- Label all costumes and shoes
- Check in at table in lobby
- You will then watch the show from the audience. ABSOLUTELY NO DANCERS IN THE AUDIENCE. (This does not apply to the Sat 10:30am Tippy Toez class. Dancers will be permitted to be picked up by the parent who dropped them off during our 15 min intermission and watch the rest of the show from the audience)
- No videography or photography during the show
- After the show, only the parent who checked in their child is permitted to pick up said child.

DRESSING ROOM ASSIGNMENTS AND ROOM MOMS

You will find out your dressing room assignment when checking in. Room moms will be announced via email.

***Please reach out to your room moms to see if there is anything you can bring or do to help out with the day of recital. For the younger ones, please consider bringing an oversized button down shirt to wear over their costumes for when they aren't performing.

HAIR

Students are required to wear their hair slicked back in a high bun with a bun donut. You can purchase a bun donut at a local pharmacy or on amazon. You want to achieve the wet look when hair is pulled back. Please wet your hair, gel it, brush it and slick back so there are no bumps or "wispies." Hair should feel like a helmet and look sleek "wet" because there is so much gel and hairspray in it! No fly aways or loose hair. Below is a link to a youtube how-to video. If your child has braids or short hair, please ensure that hair is out of the face and pulled back cleanly.

BOYS: Hair styled nicely with gel- no need for make-up

MAKE-UP

You want to ensure that all dancers have complete coverage on their face with foundation. The eyes are to be shadowed with gray smoky eye shadow and eyeliner. For lips, dancers are to wear a red/burgundy shade. Finally, finish the look with a contoured blush. For younger dancers, blush, mascara and lipstick will suffice.

COSTUMES

ABSOLUTELY NO UNDERWEAR UNDERNEATH COSTUMES. THIS GOES FOR ALL AGES. TIGHTS AND LEOTARDS ARE THE PROPER DANCE ATTIRE AND PURPOSEFULLY USED FOR THIS REASON. FOR THOSE TAKING HIP HOP, PLEASE ENSURE YOU ARE WEARING TAN TIGHTS UNDER YOUR COSTUME AS THIS TAKES THE PLACE OF UNDERWEAR. I KNOW THIS MAY SEEM ABSURD TO THOSE NEW TO DANCE, BUT I ASSURE YOU THIS PRACTICE IS UNDERSTOOD AMONGST ALL STUDIOS AND DANCERS ALIKE.
